Form How is it expressed	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• determine present skills• determine how forms are being used (facial expressions, gestures, vocalization, objects)• determine if they can hear or see (what and how)• determine student physical abilities• determine fatigue factors
Function What is the reason	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• reasons for communicating (request, opinion, draw someone's attention, answering questions, making a comment)• do they initiate conversations (when, how many times, with who)• do they respond to others (when, how many times, with who)
Content What is expressed	Factors to consider <ul style="list-style-type: none">• age• interest• culture• conversational partner• situation
